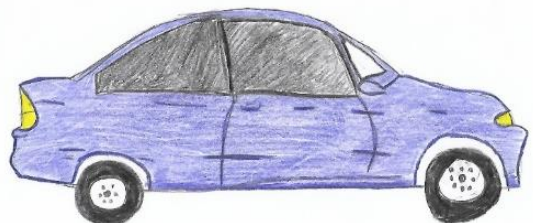
"Do you want to go with me to the grocery store today, Jaylen?" Mom asked.

"Yes, Mom, can I get my favorite cereal?" Jaylen asked.

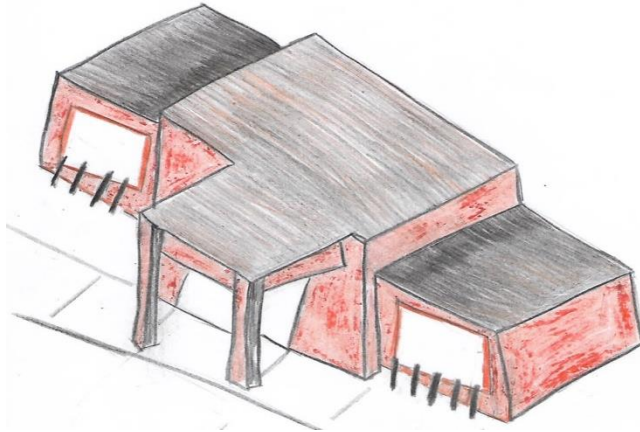
"Can I go too, Mom?" Kaleb asked.
